CMSgt Joshua A. Thomas is the Cyber Defense Operations Superintendent and Support Senior Enlisted Leader at the Mississippi Combat Readiness Training Center, Gulfport, Miss. As the Support SEL, he advises and assists the Director of Support on managerial and technical matters concerning cyber defense, computer systems, and networking. His primary focus is on fostering the professional growth and readiness of the enlisted force within the Support element, enabling effective wing-level Air National Guard readiness training. CMSgt Thomas is directly responsible to the Director of Support for the professional development, military readiness, and mission effectiveness of his section's enlisted Airmen.

CMSgt Thomas enlisted in the United States Air Force in July 2000, followed by attendance at the Ground Radio Apprentice Course at Keesler AFB, Mississippi, graduating in March, 2002. He has served for over 25 years in the Air National Guard, accruing extensive experience in technical and leadership roles within both radio frequency transmissions and cyber defense operations. At the Combat Readiness Training Center in Gulfport, Mississippi, he continued to serve as a Radio Frequency (RF) Transmissions Systems Craftsman. During his fourteen years at the Combat Readiness Training Center, he expanded his expertise to include Cyber Defense Operations, directly supporting wing-level Air National Guard readiness training in both areas.
